

## **Course Costs and Terms & Conditions**

### **Course Fees:**

Please note that some courses require preparatory work to be completed PRIOR to attendance. To assist your learning the relevant DVD and/or book where there is one will be sent to you once you are fully registered and the course is paid for.

Please note failure to do the preparatory work will be taken seriously and may result in being unable to take part in the workshop if it is felt by the master trainer that the lack of preparation would affect the quality of the workshop experience for others.

If you wish to be considered for any instructor and / or update certification you will need a current first aid certificate please see registration form for details

### **Registration:**

Registration will only be accepted up to two weeks prior to the course date to allow for the pre course preparation. Registration will only be regarded as complete and a place confirmed when full payment has been received. Invoices can be issued but payment must be received in time for the goods to be dispatched for the two week preparation time.

**Cancellations:** received up to two full weeks before the workshops are refundable minus a £20 registration administration charge. After that time cancellations are subject to the entire workshop fee. Please note that if you don't cancel and don't attend, you are still responsible for full payment.

**Goods:** (DVD or books) sent as part of registration on any course are non returnable. Consequently they will be charged for in the event of cancellation or non attendance at the standard cost plus postage – typically £25. This will be in addition to any other charges.

**Substitutions:** may be made at any time up to the start of the course **provided** both a completed registration form containing all the required details is produced and the participant can demonstrate to the Master Trainer that they have completed all the required preparatory work for the course to an acceptable level. If the Master Trainer is not satisfied on either count the substitution will not be allowed and it will be treated as a non-attendance.

**Insurance for Shibashi Instructors :** To be considered for an instructor's certificate, current professional indemnity, malpractice, public & products liability insurance valid and appropriate to this course must be proven.
